

Accoya Requirements

- 1. Always use stainless steel fixing (Spax Stainless Steel screws are specified in Europe)
- 2. Pre-drill Accoya
- 3. Always place a barrier between Accoya and sub frame. For example plastic stripping NOT PAINTED ON BARRIER.
- 4. See the Accoya Tech Info Sheet Weathering to find out about the weathering process and expectations of the timber.

Quotation Terms and Conditions

- Terms 30-day account if established and within limits or payment prior to delivery.
